Captain John Paul Stapp, already a medical doctor, began his scientific career in the 1940s studying the negative effects of high altitude flight, issues absolutely critical to the future of aviation. How could men survive these conditions? The problem of the bends, the deadly formation of bubbles in the bloodstream, proved the toughest, but after 65 hours in the air, Stapp found an answer. Stapp's life was never the same after that successful run on 10 December 1954. Dubbed 'The Fastest Man on Earth' by the media, his celebrity rose to dazzling heights. Stapp graced the pages of magazines, and became the subject of a Hollywood movie. If the attention was a bit much for the soft spoken Lt. With full respect to the incredible achievements of Usain Bolt, technically the fastest man ever is* a three way tie between American Astronauts Thomas Stafford, John W. Young and Eugene Cernan of the Apollo 10 crew who achieved the highest speed relative to Earth ever attained by humans; 39,897 km/h (11.082 km/s, 24,791 mph which is approx. 0.0037 percent of the speed of Light. The record was set 26 May 1969 - and is over 32 times faster than the fastest speed achieved for a manned vehicle on earth, in other words over 32 times faster than the speed of sound Continue Reading.
