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Other assessment techniques include consultation, focused analysis, peer assessment and self-assessment. The Position and Guidelines state that: "Observation involves teachers in observing students as they participate in planned activities. Teacher observation occurs continually as a natural part of the learning and teaching process and can be used to gather a broad range of information about students' demonstrations of learning outcomes" (p. 16). Planned observation involves deliberate planning of an opportunity for the teacher to observe specific learning outcomes. This planned opportunity may occur in the context of regular classroom activities or may occur through the setting of an assessment task (such as a practical or performance activity).²

Observation, Assessment and Planning. EYFS Statutory Assessment. The Early Years Profile is to remain statutory for the time being. However, following the decision to abandon on-entry assessment of children entering reception classes last year there has now been a consultation: Primary Assessment in England which invited views about the perceived need for a form of baseline assessment. And, not unexpectedly this was endorsed so, it is now in the offing.
